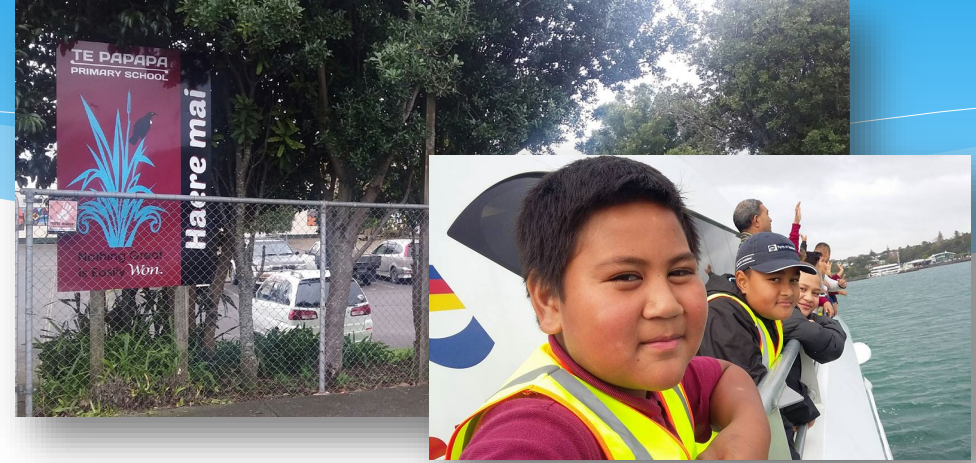
We foster friendly caring Youth communities to achieve:

How Do We Achieve These Goals?

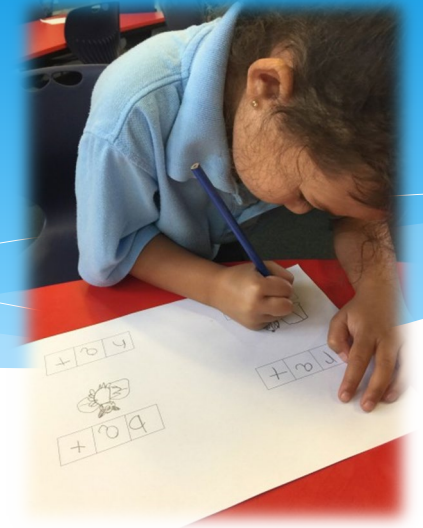


...By forming Junior Neighbourhood Support Groups
